- A rapid test for COVID-19 will be administered.
- A mask must be worn at all times while in common areas.
- Social distancing and hand hygiene should be maintained.
- Per CMS and DOH guidelines, visitation is to happen in resident rooms so as to minimize possible exposure. Visitation and congregation in common areas is not allowed.
